

OPERATING SYSTEM

•software that supports a computer's basic functions, recognizing the input data from a keyboard, sending output to the display screen, keeping files and directories of the disk and controlling peripheral devices like printers

interface between user and machine

TYPES OF OPERATING SYSTEM

- Normal Operating System
- Real Time Operating System

classified into two types:


- Character User Interface OS
- Graphical User Interface OS

Character User Interface OS (CUI)

•text-based OS, used for interacting with the software or files by typing commands to perform specific tasks

 Command Line OS uses only keyboard to enter commands

Example: DOS and UNIX




Graphical User Interface OS (GUI)

 mouse-based OS (Windows OS, LINUX), wherein a user performs the tasks or operations without typing the commands from the keyboard

• files or icons can be opened or closed by clicking them with a mouse button

•Microsoft created the Windows OS in the mid-1980s

Versions: Windows 10, Windows8, Windows 7, Windows XP

• Editions: Home, Premium, Professional, Ultimate

APPLE MAC OS X

•MAC OS is a line of OS created by Apple Inc.


•Versions: MAC OS X, Lion, Snow Leopard, Leopard

Mac OS X Graphical User Interface OS (GUI)


LINUX
